## **Welcome Meetings** We hope that everyone who attended our recent Class Welcome Meetings found them informative. Well done to Year 4, where 60% of parents joined us, the highest percentage in the school!

**Attendance** Attending school every day is crucial for your child's academic success. In accordance with new Government guidelines, penalty notice fines will be issued for unauthorised absences during term time, persistent absences and persistence lateness to school. Any request for term time absence must be submitted in advance on our <u>Absence Request Form</u> (paper copies available from the school office). Term time leave will not be authorised unless evidence of exceptional circumstances provided and a penalty notice may be issued.

1st offence	<ul> <li>£80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days</li> <li>£160 per parent, per child if paid after 21 days</li> </ul>
<b>2nd offence</b> (within three years of the 1st offence)	<ul> <li>£160 per parent, per child paid within 28 days</li> </ul>
<b>3rd offence</b> (within three years of the 1st offence)	<ul> <li>Application for prosecution submitted to Magistrates Court. Fines can by up to £2,500 per parent, per child.</li> </ul>

## Fines for unauthorised term time or unauthorised irregular attendance leave are as follows:

**Library Books** We pride ourselves on providing the children at Queensgate with a wide range of inspiring books in our Library. Mrs Lee (English Lead) and Mrs Griffiths put a lot of thought into which new books we can purchase and work very hard to make the Library an inviting space. Sadly, last year many of our books were lost and not returned to school or were damaged. We are not able to replace these books due to a lack of funds. Therefore, if a book goes missing, a sticker will be placed in your child's Reading Record to let you know the title of the missing book. Your child will not be able to take home another book, until the book is returned. If the book has not been returned by the following week, a £5 charge will be issued on Parent Pay. Once the £5 charge has been paid, your child will be able to access the Library books as normal.

**Parent Partnership Meeting** We regularly hold an informal Parent Partnership meeting on the school premises and all parents/ carers are welcome to attend. The purpose of the meetings is for parents to meet members of staff, to share information about areas of the curriculum or initiatives that we are reviewing and to gain your views and suggestions. It is also a good way for parents/carers to meet other parents and be part of the Queensgate community. Our next meeting is on **Thursday 10th October** at 8.55AM in Larks and Owls. Mrs Lofthouse and myself will be attending the meeting and we are hoping to obtain suggestions and feedback on how we can ensure that children and families from all cultures, faiths and backgrounds feel part of our school and local community. Refreshments are provided and we would love to see you there.
