Year 6 SATs results

As you will be aware, each May, Year 6 children in England complete SATs tests in reading, grammar and spelling and maths. Children's writing is assessed by the teacher. This week, the Department for Education has validated schools data and we can now share these with you.

We had another very positive set of results this summer and as you can see below, Queensgate's Year 6 results are significantly above the national averages in all areas. These children have now left Queensgate to start the next phase of their education. We know that they will be well-equipped for future success and we wish them lots of happiness and success on their journey.
