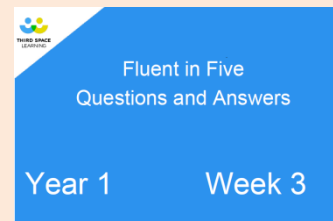
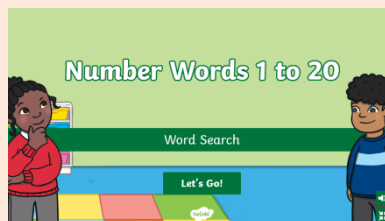
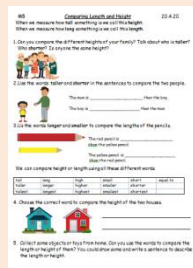
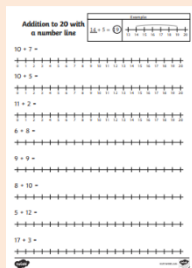
Hope you have all enjoyed Easter, the lovely sunny weather and managed to find lots of eggs too! Some new home learning for this week.

English Tasks



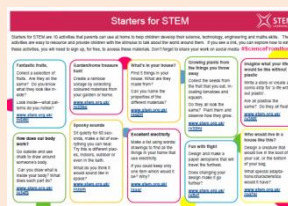

1. **Addition** - Complete these calculations using the numberline.
2. **Comparing length and height** - Describe objects as longer, taller or shorter.

4. **Fluent in Five** - Three quick arithmetic questions every day.
