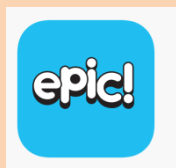
Year Five Home Learning

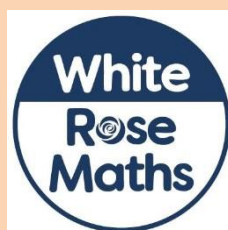

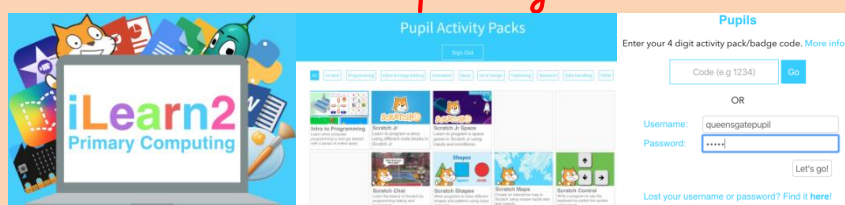
Topic Task
