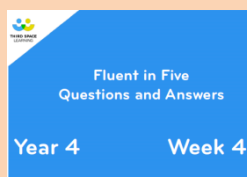


3. Read this week's edition of First News. See the attached file.

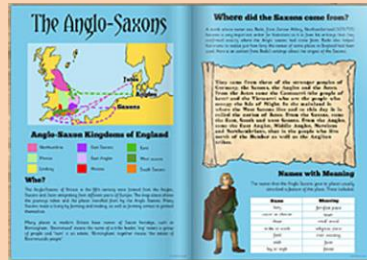

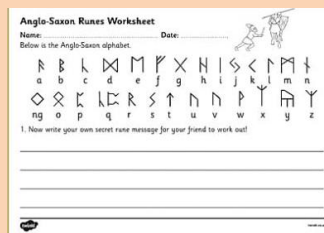

e.g.
Ça va?
Ça va.
