We are currently in 4th place on Spelling Shed (we're behind Reception?!), but not far off so let's try and beat them (sorry Reception!).

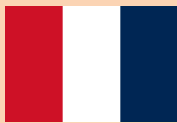
TT Rockstars - Well done to those children who are using TT Rockstars. I have set up a battle against Year 4 this week. Do me proud!

There is a Parents and Carers help sheet to read first. See Attached files.

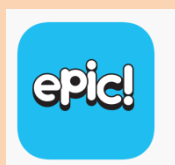
Ongoing English Tasks

Continue to work on the Talk for Writing unit from last week. You could write your answers up into a note book rather than printing off the sheets if that is easier. Happy writing!

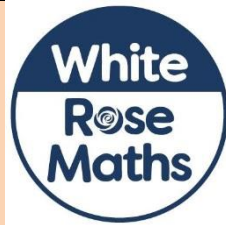
