Polar Animals - Choose which of the three reading comprehensions is best suited to your reading level and answer the questions that follow. Remember - the answers are always in the text!

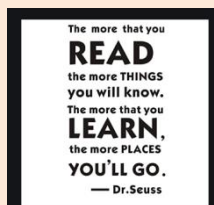
## Ongoing Weekly English Tasks...

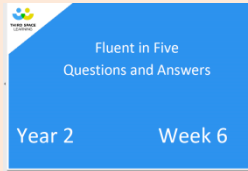
