Maths Task

Ordering numbers and missing numbers.

- Draw number lines in chalk and ask your child to fill in the missing numbers. You don't have to start from one!
- Put numbers into a bowl of water /jelly, pull them out and put them in order
- Write numbers onto cards, shuffle them in a bag and ask your child to put them into order
- Write a number line on a lolly stick, leave a gap for a missing number ask your child to replace the missing number chose from a peg with numbers written on.
