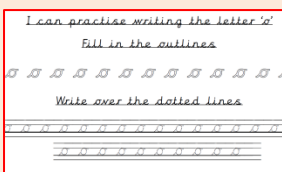

Maths Tasks



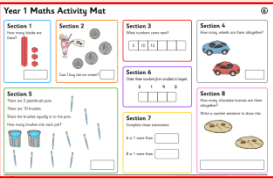
