### Making Pitta pizzas

Can you make pizzas (with help from mum or dad) measuring these ingredients and following these instructions.

#### Pitta pizzas

##### Ingredients

|                                    |             |
|------------------------------------|-------------|
| Pitta bread (white or whole wheat) | 4           |
| Sun dried Tomato puree             | 4 teaspoons |
| Plum tomatoes                      | 3, chopped  |
| Ham (or chorizo, or pepperoni)     | 85g, diced  |
| Cheddar cheese                     | 50g, grated |

You could add some other toppings of your choice.

##### Method

1. Switch on the oven to 200C/180C (fan)
2. Collect the equipment that you will need - a bowl, a knife, a teaspoon,
3. Spread each pitta with 1 teaspoon of the tomato puree.
4. Top the pittas with the chopped tomatoes, ham and sprinkle over the cheese and any other toppings that you are adding.
5. Place on a baking tray and carefully put them in the oven  
ASK AN ADULT TO HELP YOU.
6. Bake for 10 minutes until the cheese has melted.
7. Serve with a green salad.
